

To prevent the spread of infectious diseases by overseas animal products such as **African Swine Fever, Foot and Mouth Disease, Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza,** etc.

Carrying animal products such as raw meat, ham, sausage and beef jerky to Korea is prohibited,

if such products are carried in by accident, please indicate what you are carrying in the **Customs Declaration Form and report it to the Quarantine Office at each airport and port**.

International mail or express mail, such as direct overseas purchase, are also restricted.

Failing to report carrying animal products

could result in a fines of up to 10 million KRW

※ Foreigners committing such violations may be at disadvantage including, the prohibition of entry, limitation on stay, etc.
